

# Ozaukee County Fairest of the Fair

## Schedule of Required Appearances:

- ❖ All five days of the Ozaukee County Fair
  - Skirt/dress, wear sash & crown (daytime)
  - Formal dress, wear sash & crown (evenings)
- ❖ State Fairest of the Fair Reunion (usually the Monday after our County Fair)
  - Skirt/dress, wear sash & crown
- ❖ Ozaukee County Leader's Banquet (end of October)
  - Skirt/dress, wear sash & crown
- ❖ Grafton Christmas Parade (November)
  - Dress warmly (a formal dress is not required), wear sash & crown
- ❖ Annual Meeting of the Agricultural Society (1<sup>st</sup> Friday in December)
  - Skirt/dress, wear sash & crown
  - Short introduction and thank you expected, sometimes leads the Pledge of Allegiance
- ❖ State competition (Early January)
  - See rules, mostly business suits, NO crown or sash (a new sash will be provided at State)
  - Create a gift basket of donations from around the county to auction at the competition
- ❖ Ozaukee County 4-H Dance (for the International 4-H Youth Exchange Program IFYE)
  - February or March
  - Skirt/dress, wear sash & crown
- ❖ Ozaukee County 4-H Variety Show (March)
  - Skirt/dress, wear sash & crown
- ❖ Memorial Day Celebration with the Waubeka 4-H Club
  - Skirt/dress, wear sash & crown
  - Asked to participate in celebration
- ❖ Flag Day Parade (early June)
  - Skirt/dress, wear sash & crown
  - Short welcome speech during celebration ceremony at Flag Day Foundation
- ❖ Breakfast on the Farm (early morning, usually 3<sup>rd</sup> weekend in June)
  - Skirt/dress, wear sash & crown
- ❖ Thiensville Family Day Parade (end of June)
  - Formal dress, sash & crown
- ❖ 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parades: Cedarburg & Grafton & Friesdadt
  - Formal dress, sash & crown
- ❖ Fish Day Parade in Port Washington (3<sup>rd</sup> weekend in July)
  - Formal dress, sash & crown

Other Duties:

- ❖ Prepare for state, read up on agricultural, political, and cultural issues in Wisconsin and Ozaukee County. Talk to Sara Priaulx, Natalie Salkowski, or Patti Roden about the competition. Prepare a self-introduction and 30-second commercial.
- ❖ Ask for and pick-up donations for the next years Fairest of the Fair contest (May-July).  
\*\*\*Wear sash! Bring a letter with your request as well as a donation form.
- ❖ Attend all Fairest of the Fair meetings.
- ❖ Contact candidates that you think would make a great successor.
- ❖ Help promote our County Fair by giving speeches and meeting with local schools, 4-H groups, and other community clubs.
- ❖ Attend interviews and final competition on the first day of County Fair (both the year you run and the year after)  
\*\*\*Dress professionally for interviews, formal for contest, and of course wear crown & sash.
