

Wisconsin Fairest of the Fairs Title Brought Back to Ozaukee County

On January 11, 2006, our 2005 Fairest of the Fair, Kimberly Schoessow, brought the Wisconsin Fairest of the Fairs title back to Ozaukee County after over 20 years. Kimberly competed against 30 qualified women for the state title in Green Bay, each participating in an extensive interview process. The competition is held in conjunction with the Wisconsin Association of Fairs annual convention. The first night of convention, the contestants auction off an item or basket of items that highlight their county or district. The second day is filled with individual interviews and a preliminary presentation of 30-second commercials and impromptu question and answer session. On the third day of the convention and competition, the contestants participated in 30-minute group interviews and the top ten and top five each went through more impromptu question and answer sessions.



As the 2006 Wisconsin Fairest of the Fairs, Kimberly has the enjoyable task of traveling the state all summer attending many county and district fairs and other fair related events. She will conduct media interviews and encourage attendance at these fairs through parades and other promotional activities. She will also serve as the official hostess to the Wisconsin State Fair, August 3-13, 2006 located in West Allis, Wisconsin.
