In approximately four months the Ozaukee County Fair will observe its 159th anniversary. The major event, as in the past, will be the two days of competition for the demolition derbies. FRIDAY, August 3rd the competition begins at 6:30 PM and SATURDAY, August 4th the competition begins at **6 PM.** (please note—**WE ARE BACK TO FRIDAY AND SATURDAY AGAIN THIS YEAR.**

THE RULES AND REGULATIONS HAVE CHANGED. PLEASE READ THE ATTACHED SHEETS. RULES & REGULATIONS 2018 AND THE DRIVER/PIT CREW GUIDELINES.

The competition will be conducted as it has been in previous years. We will qualify drivers both days for TWO Grand Finale Championships that will be held ON SATURDAY EVENING. Thus, it will be to your advantage to compete the first night, and if you fail to qualify at that time, you will still be eligible to try again on SATURDAY. There will be a restriction of 125 entries per day. However, **no demolition cars or entries will be accepted into the gate after 5:30 PM Friday night and 5 PM on SATURDAY.** This will be enforced...with no exceptions!

Competition vehicles will be divided into separate heats. **New for 2018** - compact cars and midsize cars will be combined into one heat and chain-n-go will have its own heat, There will be two heats that contain Compact Pickups, SUV's and Minivans 2WD and Compact Pickups, SUV's and Minivans 4WD. Full Size Pickups 2WD have a separate heat as well as the Full Size Pickups 4WD will have their own heat. Convertibles can also be utilized; **1977 & newer vehicles only.** The Amateur Heat (14-15 year olds) will also be repeated this year. You must have written permission from a legal guardian and submit a copy of their birth certificate. They will compete in one heat only—against kids in the same age group. As a reminder, you will not be permitted to reinforce the basic structure, frame, (no hitches), body or suspension. You may modify your car mechanically as you wish.

In an effort to expedite registration, we are again assigning numbers in advance to those contestants who competed in 2017. LARGE plain numbers must be on the **ROOF and door panels (REMEMBER TO PLACE THE CORRECT LETTER AFTER YOUR NUMBER TO DESIGNATE WHICH TYPE OF HEAT YOU ARE IN—for example; Limited Bonestock 200B, Chain-N-Go 200CG, Midsize Car 200M, Compact Car 200C, Compact Pickup 200CP, Compact Pickup Four Wheel Drive - 200CP4X4 , or Full Size Pickup 200P, Full Size Pickup Four Wheel Drive - 200P4x4, Minivan 200V or Minivan Four Wheel Drive - 200V4x4, Amateurs just use their number.** Obviously, this is important since it will make you readily identifiable to the crowd in the grandstand and also to our announcer who can report your progress during the competition. **We would like to see more numbers displayed largely on Roof Tops this year and an "X" largely printed on Drivers Door (use White if a dark colored vehicle and Black if a light colored vehicle.**

Your number for the 2018 competition is _____.

For your convenience, I am enclosing a registration form. Please fill the form out entirely (include car/truck number and letter) and enclose your check payable to GRAND MOTOR CRASH, INC. and mail to the address indicated above NO LATER THAN 7-20-18. To receive a confirmation of your desired date of competition and heat number, please send a self-addressed, stamped envelope. The registration fee is \$50.00 if paid by 7/20/18, entries received after 7/20 will be charged \$60.00 to enter. Members of your pit crew will be charged \$15.00, which as you know provides them with insurance coverage while they are working in the pits.

It would be in your best interest to haul your vehicles to the fairgrounds as per state traffic laws. You will be ticketed at the gate if you are not obeying the law. The police will not allow vehicles to be driven to the grounds. See the traffic route listed on the Guidelines sheet attached. We are looking forward to seeing you again in 2018 and renewing those pleasant associations which have been developed over the past 53 years. Let me take this opportunity to wish you the best of luck in this year's competition

2018 DRIVER & PIT CREW GUIDELINES

Please do not bring vehicles that are not needed for that day.

1. Auto buyers will be available for buying demo cars BEFORE the event. Titles and/or VIN # must be presented to buyer if you wish to sell your car. Salvage yard must be registered with Grand Motor Crash, Inc.
2. **All glass** (including tail lights) must be removed from the car before it is brought onto the fairgrounds. Glass cannot be rolled down into doors, it must be removed completely.
3. **All Flammable cloth/leather/vinyl/carpet** must be removed from car/truck interiors and trunks.
4. No wood, paper, tires, car parts will not be permitted as reinforcements.
5. Concrete is not allowed in any vehicles. **NO WHEEL WEIGHTS ALLOWED!!!!**
6. Stock gasoline tanks must be removed before entering the fairgrounds.
7. No Antifreeze allowed.
8. Gates will be locked each night at 12:00 Midnight and will again open at 7:00 AM the following day. Demo cars cannot be removed from pit area after 11:00 PM. Trespassers will be arrested, forfeit prize money and be excluded from competition.
9. **Entrance will NOT be permitted through check-in infield registration gate for any reason during the demo derby.** Drivers and Pit Crew are not allowed in pits overnight.
10. Grand Prize to Champion 1st place trophy and prize money of \$500. Trophies to 2nd - \$400 and 3rd place trophy - \$300. One and done individualized heats the driver awarded 1st place \$125.00 prize money (if more than 5 in heat prize money increases to \$150.00) Prize money is also awarded for the Best Paint job. Best Hit and Best Showmanship. All qualifying heat winners going to finale receive \$50.00. The use of vulgar or obscene messages as part of your cars decoration will not be permitted.
11. **Trailers and personal vehicles will be parked just outside the previous pit area. Please do not bring vehicles that are not needed for that day.**
12. **If you are using a towing company to bring your demo vehicle tell parking people you are just dropping the vehicle off, pass is not required.**
13. Do not fly American Flags on your vehicles during competition.
14. You must be 18 years of age, or 16 with the notarized approval of parent/legal guardian. 14 and 15 year olds are permitted in one heat only with notarized approval of parent/legal guardian and copy of birth certificate. Children 9 and under are not permitted in the pit area one hour prior to demo derby or during the demo derby.
15. In cooperation with all parties involved, the following traffic route will be followed when bringing demo cars to the park.
16. **TRAFFIC ROUTE:** Haul your vehicle to the grounds. Demo cars will enter the park Northbound on Washington Avenue. If you are coming from the North use Hwy. I (Sheboygan Rd.) to Washington Ave. and then North to Gate One. To further assist you, there will be no parking on the East Side of Washington Ave. from Sheboygan Road to Gate One. A traffic officer will be at that intersection to assist with traffic. Check in for demo drivers begins at **2 PM FRIDAY & SATURDAY** at the far backside of infield.—Entrance into the park must be completed by **5:30 PM FRIDAY night and 5:00PM SATURDAY.** You will not be allowed to enter after these times. No exceptions.
17. If you are driving more than one demo vehicle, please use the **SAME NUMBER** and place the correct letter behind EACH NUMBER. Make copies of registration form first, then fill them out with all of your demo numbers. Please see front page for letters on **vehicles. Vehicles should have an "X" on driver's door** (intentional driver door hits are disqualification). Vehicles with number on Roof Top help our announcer in promoting your progress to the crowd, we highly recommend numbers on roof tops.
18. **INSPECTION LINE:** For Safety Purposes.... **Maximum of two people per car in inspection line. Stay with your own car.** Inspectors need space for inspection. This will be enforced.

** BONE STOCK LIMITED BUILD: EXCEEDING 110"

** (Rules listed below, plus additional Extended Rules for Bonestock, bottom pg. 2)

1. **RADIATORS** must be car automotive only. Radiator must be in stock location or no radiators. Tanks and barrels are not allowed. No antifreeze. Hoods will need to be opened at inspection time or have access to radiator cap. No excessive radiator guards.

2. **COWL -TWO CHAINS** can be attached from roof of car to cowl for safety purposes **FRONT ONLY**. **HOOD** — **MUST HAVE 4 CHAINS** and **TRUNK** must have 2 chains maximum of 4. No threaded rod allowed as hold down up to Cowl for reinforcement.

3. **SAFETY PURPOSES: SEAT BAR—A** Pipe or Tube not smaller than 2 inches no larger than 4 inches. Wall no thinner than 1/8 inch and no thicker than 'A' inch is recommended. Bar can only be attached to B pillar and/or rear door. Maximum of mounting plate 6" x 14" by 'A' thick. Spacer between door cannot be bigger than mounting plate. Nothing else should be attached to the seat bar; OR a minimum 2" strap may be used from dash of A pillar of passenger side to B pillar of driver's door side. This rule is designed for **SAFETY REASONS ONLY NOT FOR REINFORCEMENT**.

4. **AIR BAGS** must be removed completely—no exceptions.

5. **TWO 12" HOLES** must be cut into hood on each side of motor to put out fires on **ALL** demo cars.

6. **SAFETY HELMETS**, **(REMOVE VISOR ON MOTORCROSS HELMETS)** eye protection, seat belt and/or shoulder harness must be worn. Short sleeves/tank tops/shorts will not be allowed during competition. Pants and a jacket are recommended.

7. **GASOLINE** will be limited to 4 gallons or less. All stock **FUEL TANKS** must be completely removed and gas placed in a DOT approved container with no chance for leaks at hose connection. Must have metal fittings and approved fuel lines. Fuel tanks must be strapped down with ratchet straps or seat belt type material. Please cover tanks with nonflammable material, such as rubber floor mats.

8. **BATTERIES** must be 2 feet from gas tanks and strapped down. If two feet of space is not available (compact/mid-size), battery and gas tank must be covered up or individually wrapped. Duct tape and silicone are not acceptable coverings (**RUBBER FLOOR MATS ARE RECOMMENDED**)

9. **MAXIMUM HEIGHT LIMIT** to the extent of stock shocks **IN STOCK POSITION**.

10. **TIRES -- NO SOLID** skid loader tires, fork lift tires, paddle or tractor tires allowed, but air filled non aggressive thread Skid Tires will be allowed.—this will be up to Grand Motor Crash's discretion.

11. **REINFORCEMENT** will not be permitted to the basic structure, frame, body, suspension or driveline, no hitches. Extra welding, bolting, riveting, **NO ZIP SCREWS**, wiring or lacing of fenders for strength purposes will not be permitted. Concrete is not allowed in any demo vehicles.

12. **BUMPERS** and all factory bumper brackets must remain stock and in factory position. Two chains must go to or around bumper and be bolted to core support or body to keep the bumper from falling off on track. Bumper

shocks may be collapsed and welded but not welded to the frame. Bumper shock must be in the stock position with the stock hardware.

13. DOORS must be chained or cabled (1/4" or larger). One chain per vertical seam on doors. Chains cannot be attached to frame for reinforcement. .

14. MOVING CONTACT — Drivers must make contact with a moving car (STILL IN COMPETITION) every 60 seconds or be disqualified.

15. NO ALCOHOL BEVERAGES permitted in the pit area. FAIR BOARD CRACKING DOWN!

16. CLEANUP — All cars and car parts (bumpers, seats, tires and all loose parts) must be in your car or the provided dumpsters—even if you have sold your car to the salvage yard. Your cooperation and assistance in this cleanup procedure is very important to the continuation of future demolition derbies. Removal deadline for your car/parts is the evening of Sunday, August 7TH. Any demo cars/debris that is not removed by August 7TH becomes the property of Grand Motor Crash, Inc. NO EXCEPTIONS.

17. JUDGEMENT CALLS by track officials are final. Arguing with officials will not be tolerated. Any car out of the bricked area will be disqualified.

18. REGISTRATION FEES/PIT PASSES will not be refunded. New pit passes are purchased each day of the Event.

19. TIE WRAPS - CARS from Friday nights Event must place tie wrap on top of steering wheel after Fridays Event. This assures you that your car will not be moved to create space for incoming Saturday demo cars.

20. INSPECTION — All demo vehicles must be inspected before entering the competition. Inspection takes place in the infield at 2:00 PM Friday and Saturday. All demo cars re-entering for Saturdays Event (including qualifiers) must be inspected again by track officials before Saturday evening competition.

21. FAIR COMPETITION — Track inspectors and/or official's decisions are final. if you feel you were treated unfairly by officials, keeping your cool will help. Track officials make every effort to be fair to all participants.

22. AGE — You must be 18 years of age or provide the notarized approval of parent or legal guardian upon registration. 125 demo car/truck limit per night. 14 and 15 year-olds are permitted in Amateur heat only. They must provide notarized approval of parent or legal guardian and attach a copy of their birth certificate.

23. CAR INTERIOR — All flammable cloth/vinyl/leather/carpet from interior of vehicle and trunk must be removed.

24. TRACK OFFICIALS DECISIONS ARE FINAL.

25. NO WHEEL WEIGHTS ARE ALLOWED. NO WHEEL WEIGHTS ARE ALLO WED!

26. BUSES: We are looking for buses....if you have one you may bring it, enter and drive it on SATURDAY EVENING. PLEASE CONTACT GRAND MOTOR CRASH ASAP TO REGISTER. We would like to be able to print your name and Bus Description in Programs.

27. TO HELP PROMOTE A FAIR COMPETITION, GRAND MOTOR CRASH HAS THE DISCRETION OF FOLLOWING A BUYOUT RULE IF NEED BE AND RETAINING THE TOP 3 WINNING CARS FROM THE GRAND FINALE CHAMPIONSHIP.

28. NOTE: Trailers and personal vehicles will be parked just outside the previous pit area. Please do not bring vehicles that are not needed for that day.

BONE STOCK LIMITED BUILD EXTENDED RULES & REGULATIONS

FOLLOW ALL THE RULES LISTED ABOVE WITH THE FOLLOWING EXCEPTIONS:

1. BONE STOCK MUST HAVE THE ORIGINAL REAR END OF THAT VEHICLE. MUST ALSO HAVE STOCK MOTOR MOUNTS AND TRANSMISSION MOUNTS. TRANSMISSION SUPPORT MAYBE RELOCATED NO LONGER THAN A 6 INCH MOUNT. NO MODIFICATIONS OR ALTERATIONS TO THE FRAME IN ANY WAY. NO SLIDER DRIVE SHAFTS AND NO DISTRIBUTOR GUARDS ARE ALLOWED.

2. NO CHANGING OF BODY BOLTS, NO OVERSIZED WASHERS, AND NO ALTERATIONS TO STOCK MOUNT.

3. The only things you may change in Bone stock Class are: Radiator, Motor, Transmission, Drive Shafts (NO SLIDER DRIVESHAFTS). Shifter must be attached to transmission only.

4. FOR BUMPERS PLEASE READ NUMBER 12 ON PAGE 1.

5. CLEANUP IS VERY IMPORTANT. BE SURE TO PICKUP ALL LOOSE PARTS AND DEBRIS AND PLACE INSIDE YOUR CAR WHEN DEMOS ARE COMPLETED. THIS GREATLY REDUCES CLEANUP AFTERWARDS.

6. PLEASE KEEP IN MIND THIS IS A LIMITED BUILD BONESTOCK CLASS!!!

2018 RULES & REGULATIONS

STANDARD PICKUPS:	1/2 & 3/4 TON 2WD

4X4 PICKUPS:	1/2 & 3/4 TON 4WD

1. Standard pickup heat is a 2 wheel drive class. No 4-wheel drives allowed. Tires must be DOT truck approved. All wheel weights must be removed.
2. Body of truck must be in stock position. No raising or lowering of bed. Spring and shackles must be in factory position. Body must be in stock position. No lift kits. Truck must have working suspension (BOUNCE).
3. Air bags must be removed completely—no exceptions.
4. All stock gas tanks must be removed. Gas must be placed in DOT approved container with no chance of leaks at hose connection. Gas may be placed in bed of truck near cab. Gasoline is limited to 4 gallons.
5. All street stock% and % ton trucks are used (compact pickups limited to 4-6 cylinder engines). No commercial vehicles, ambulances or vans.
6. Extra radiators will not be permitted. For safety purposes, two chains should be attached from roof of truck to cowl.
7. Two (2) twelve inch holes must be cut in hood. Doors and hood must be chained or cabled (1/4" or larger). Hood must have 4 chains (NOT welded or laced). Chains cannot be attached to frame for reinforcement. No threaded rod allowed for reinforcement. Must have access to radiator cap.
8. Fans may be removed; batteries may be moved but must be 2 feet from gas tanks and strapped down (no bungee cords). Two batteries are allowed. **If two feet of space is not available, battery and gas tank must be covered up or individually wrapped. Duct tape and silicone are not acceptable coverings (use floor mat, etc.)**
9. No reinforcement on front or rear of truck. No special bumpers are allowed - **ORIGINAL FACTORY STOCK TRUCK BUMPERS ONLY** in stock position. **Front stays on front back stays on the back.**
10. Must make contact with a moving truck (still in competition) every 60 seconds or be disqualified. Must be able to move truck in order to win heat. In other words, no rocking back and forth in one place with engine running (this will not win). Also no tapping of stalled trucks will be allowed.
11. If truck is to be sold after the event you will need title for the salvage buyer. Salvage buyers must be registered with Grand Motor Crash, Inc.
12. Safety helmets, eye protection, long sleeve shirts and pants, seat belt and/or harness must be worn during competition. Jackets are recommended.
13. All trucks must be inspected. Track officials' decisions are final. **ALL WHEEL WEIGHTS MUST BE REMOVED! REMOVE VISOR ON ALL MOTORCROSS HELMETS.**
NO ALCOHOL PERMITTED IN PIT AREA WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

1977 & NEWER — COMPACT — MIDSIZE — ANYSIZE VEHICLE (NO TRUCKS)

1. **RADIATORS** must be car automotive only. Radiator must be in stock location or no radiators. Tanks and barrels are not allowed. No antifreeze. Hoods will need to be opened at inspection time or have access to radiator cap. No excessive radiator guards.
2. **COWL** -TWO CHAINS can be attached from roof of car to cowl for safety purposes **FRONT ONLY**. **HOOD** — MUST HAVE 4 CHAINS and TRUNK must have 2 chains maximum of 4. No threaded rod allowed as hold down to cowl for reinforcement.
3. **SAFETY PURPOSES: SEAT BAR**—A Pipe or Tube not smaller than 2 inches no larger than 4 inches. Wall no thinner than 1/8 inch and no thicker than 1/2 inch is recommended. 5. **TWO 12" HOLES** must be cut into hood on each side of motor to put out fires on ALL demo cars.
6. **SAFETY HELMETS**, **(REMOVE VISOR ON MOTORCROSS HELMETS)** eye protection, seat belt and/or shoulder harness must be worn. Short sleeves/tank tops/shorts will not be allowed during competition. Pants and a jacket are recommended.
7. **GASOLINE** will be limited to 4 gallons or less. All stock **FUEL TANKS** must be completely removed and gas placed in a DOT approved container with no chance for leaks at hose connection. Must have metal fittings and approved fuel lines. Fuel tanks must be strapped down with ratchet straps or seat belt type material. Please cover tanks with nonflammable material, such as rubber floor mats.
8. **BATTERIES** must be 2 feet from gas tanks and strapped down. If two feet of space is not available (compact/mid-size), battery and gas tank must be covered up or individually wrapped. Duct tape and silicone are not acceptable coverings (**RUBBER FLOOR MATS ARE RECOMMENDED**)
9. **NO ALTERATIONS TO STOCK SUSPENSION. D.O.T. TIRES ONLY.**
10. **REINFORCEMENT** will not be permitted to the basic structure, frame, body, suspension or driveline, no hitches. Extra welding, bolting, riveting, **NO ZIP SCREWS**, wiring or lacing of fenders for strength purposes will not be permitted. Concrete is not allowed in any demo vehicles.
11. **BUMPERS — STOCK ONLY IN FACTORY POSITION.** Two chains must go on to or around bumper and be bolted to core support or body to keep bumper from falling on track. **NO WELDING**
12. **DOORS** must be chained or cabled (1/4" or larger). One chain per vertical seam on doors. Chains cannot be attached to frame for reinforcement.
13. **MOVING CONTACT — Drivers must make contact with a moving car (STILL IN COMPETITION) every 60 seconds or be disqualified.**
14. **NO ALCOHOL BEVERAGES** permitted in the pit area. **FAIR BOARD CRACKING DOWN!**
15. **CLEANUP** — All cars and car parts (bumpers, seats, tires and all loose parts) must be in your car or the provided dumpsters—even if you have sold your car to the salvage yard. Your cooperation and assistance in this cleanup procedure is very important to the continuation of future demolition derbies. Removal deadline for your car/parts is the evening of Sunday, August 7TH. Any demo cars/debris that is not removed by August 7TH becomes the property of Grand Motor Crash, Inc. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

16. JUDGEMENT CALLS by track officials are final. Arguing with officials will not be tolerated. Any car out of the bricked area will be disqualified.
17. REGISTRATION FEES/PIT PASSES will not be refunded. New pit passes are purchased each day of the Event.
18. TIE WRAPS - CARS from Friday nights Event must place tie wrap on top of steering wheel after Fridays Event. This assures you that your car will not be moved to create space for incoming Saturday demo cars.
19. INSPECTION — All demo vehicles must be inspected before entering the competition. Inspection takes place in the infield at 2:00 PM Friday and Saturday. All demo cars re-entering for Saturdays Event (including qualifiers) must be inspected again by track officials before Saturday evening competition.
20. FAIR COMPETITION — Track inspectors and/or official's decisions are final. If you feel you were treated unfairly by officials, keeping your cool will help. Track officials make every effort to be fair to all participants.
21. AGE You must be 18 years of age or provide the notarized approval of parent or legal guardian upon registration. 125 demo car/truck limit per night. 14 and 15 year-olds are permitted in Amateur heat only. They must provide notarized approval of parent or legal guardian and attach a copy of their birth certificate.
22. CAR INTERIOR — All flammable cloth/vinyl/leather/carpet from interior of vehicle and trunk must be removed.
23. TRACK OFFICIALS DECISIONS ARE FINAL.
24. NO WHEEL WEIGHTS ARE ALLOWED. NO WHEEL WEIGHTS ARE ALLOWED!
25. BUSES: We are looking for buses....if you have one you may bring it, enter and drive it on SATURDAY EVENING. PLEASE CONTACT GRAND MOTOR CRASH ASAP TO REGISTER. We would like to be able to print your name and Bus Description in Programs.
26. TO HELP PROMOTE A FAIR COMPETITION, GRAND MOTOR CRASH HAS THE DISCRETION OF FOLLOWING A BUYOUT RULE IF NEED BE AND RETAINING THE TOP 3 WINNING CARS FROM THE GRAND FINALE CHAMPIONSHIP.
27. NOTE: Trailers and personal vehicles will be parked just outside the previous pit area. Please do not bring vehicles that are not needed for that day.
28. CHILDREN 9 AND UNDER ARE NOT ALLOWED IN PIT AREA ONE HOUR PRIOR TO DEMO DERBY OR DURING THE DEMO DERBY.
