Dear Ozaukee County Fair Board,

Hi my name is Chris Berg, with the Washington Ozaukee Public Health Department. I am reaching out to you in regards to the Ozaukee County Fair. As of July 1, 2018 our department will be handling all food service inspections in Washington and Ozaukee Counties. Our department looks forward to the opportunity to serve you and the community. We understand that this new change can be a bit confusing and would like to give you a few details of what program changes to expect.

We plan to work with you in any way possible to ensure public health at your community event. Our department offers a local temporary food vendor license for an annual fee of \$125.00. This license is valid until June 30th of the following year and can be used in both counties.

If food vendors opt to obtain a temporary food service license from the State of Wisconsin, we do have the right to inspect their set-up and to charge an inspection fee of \$75.00. Please feel free to pass this information along to your vendors.

There are licensing exemptions for non-profit organizations, which we can discuss.

To ensure we can properly staff your event, it is helpful to have a list of food service dates and times, and the food vendors expected at your event. If the above information can be provided at least 2 weeks prior to the event date, it would be much appreciated.

We look forward to working with you towards building a healthier community. Please do not hesitate to contact me, I am here to help answer your licensing questions.
