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ENTRY RULES AND REGULATIONS

**NOTE: all Open Department - Class Numbers begin with the number 3.
Senior Citizens Class Numbers begin with 62.**

Class Numbers that begin with the number 4 are 4-H Department only.

ANY EXHIBIT ENTERED INCORRECTLY WILL BE SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION AND CONSEQUENCES UP TO AND INCLUDING REMOVAL FROM THE BUILDING/GROUNDS PRIOR TO JUDGING.

- Online Entries must be submitted by July 1.
- No changes will be allowed after entry deadline.
- **EXHIBITORS ARE LIMITED TO ONE ENTRY IN ANY ONE CLASS.**
- **EXHIBITOR ENTRY TAGS MUST BE PICKED UP AT THE EXPO/EXHIBIT BUILDING.**
- Fair exhibits, including poultry and rabbits, must be removed between 8 and 9 p.m. on Sunday.

The Fair Association reserves the right to amend or add to these rules as they, in their judgment, deem advisable, and to limit the number of entries in any department.

General Rules

1. It is a privilege to participate in the Ozaukee County Fair. This privilege can be revoked for conduct unbecoming an exhibitor, parent, leader or volunteer. Exhibitors not adhering to rules may be disqualified, lose awards, premium and/or lose eligibility to exhibit at the Ozaukee County Fair.
2. It is the Exhibitor's responsibility to be aware of all dates, deadlines and updates, which may be emailed or posted online.
3. No Changes will be allowed after Entry deadline.
4. The Ozaukee County Fair Board reserves the right to interpret the rules and regulations listed in this entry information.
5. The Ozaukee County Fair Park is not responsible for LOST, STOLEN, OR DAMAGED articles, or for INJURY or DEATH of livestock. Owners/exhibitors assume responsibility. Exhibitors exhibit at their own risk.
6. The Ozaukee County Fair Board has the right to publish, and copyright any exhibitors image (including audio, moving image or photography) for educational programs, websites, and promotion of its programs.
7. All rules apply to all departments unless stated otherwise.
8. Open and Senior department entries in Departments 17 - 28 are open to Ozaukee and adjoining county residents, as space permits.
9. Junior Exhibitors must be 8-19 years of age on January 1 of the current fair year Ozaukee County Fair Junior department entries are open to members of 4-H, FFA, a scouting program, a breed group, or another recognized youth organization under adult leadership which has an education program appropriate to that organization and is approved by the Fair prior to January 1st of the current Fair year.
10. 4-H Cloverbuds in Kindergarten – Grade 2, may exhibit in Dept. 4-17, under Cloverbuds.
11. In all Youth Departments, Grade is based on the most recent school year.
12. All Exhibitors are limited to one entry in each Class unless otherwise stated. An exhibitor cannot exhibit an article or animal in both 4-H and Open Classes.
13. No entry shall compete for more than one premium except showmanship (livestock exhibits).
14. Every 4-H Exhibitor must be enrolled in each project he/she enters. All project exhibits must be the work of the 4-H member during the most recent 4-H project year, and may not have been shown at a previous Ozaukee County Fair with the exception of animal projects.

15. Any exhibit containing illegal or protected materials will be disqualified.
16. Superintendents have charge of all matters in their respective departments; receive and attend the proper arrangement of everything intended for exhibition therein; attend the judges in their examination; see that the program is faithfully carried out; and at the close of the exhibition, authorize the removal of exhibits.
17. Any exhibit entered incorrectly will be subject to disqualification and consequences up to and including removal from the building/grounds prior to judging.
18. Exhibitors entered in Face to Face Judging Divisions must be present when their exhibits are being judged. Licensed judges will ask youth questions about their project.
19. Animal Exhibits:
 - a. ALL animal exhibitors must comply with the Animal Health Regulations for Fairs and Shows in Wisconsin.
 - b. Premises ID number must be included at the time of entry submission.
 - c. All 4-H animal exhibits must be shown by the 4-H member who is exhibiting the animal.
 - In the event a substitute show person is needed for the second market animal in a weight class or for a youth excused for extenuating circumstances, the substitute **must** be a currently enrolled Ozaukee County 4-H member of comparable grade/age.
 - The Department Superintendent must be notified of any substitutes before judging begins, they have authorization for the above listed decisions.
 - d. Animals not properly cleaned/groomed, halter broke or unsafe may be disqualified or forfeit premiums.
 - e. May not be unloaded or placed in housing facility until all necessary papers are checked by Fair Staff. Failure to do so may result in quarantine, disqualification and/or the animal being removed from the Fair Park.
 - f. Fitting: Only the exhibitor, immediate family (father, mother, grandparents, sibling or guardian), another Ozaukee County Fair exhibitor or authorized organizational leader will be allowed to assist with show preparation/fitting at during the Fair. Animals may be in designated areas only. Additional rules can be found under the Ozaukee County Fair Ethics Policy.
 - g. Are at the risk of the exhibitor at all times. Proper animal husbandry management which includes feed, bedding, daily care and animal health is the responsibility of the exhibitor unless stated otherwise.
 - h. 4-H Small Animal Sale rules are available from members of the 4-H Small Animal Sale Committee.
 - i. 4-H Livestock Sale rules are available from the 4-H Livestock Association.
 - j. The Fair Board reserves the right to ear tag any livestock entered at the fair.
20. No advertising may be posted on any building unless approved by Fair Management.
21. No canopies allowed on the Fair Park grounds without prior approval of Fair Management unless part of designated camping which is authorized by Fair Management only.
22. All exhibits must be in place by the specified entry check-in deadline. Exhibits arriving after the deadline may not be eligible to be judged.
23. Entry tags will be printed for all classes and must be picked up at the Expo Center until noon of Wednesday of Fair Week. Starting at noon, tags can be obtained at the Fair Office.
24. **UNAUTHORIZED REMOVAL OF EXHIBITS WILL RESULT IN LOSS OF PREMIUM CHECKS.**
25. After 8:00 p.m. on Sunday, the Agricultural Society is not responsible for exhibits left on the fairgrounds.
26. For release times refer to Judging Schedule located online.

Ethics Policy

1. Tampering, and/or inhumane treatment; and/or misrepresentation as to breeding, age, ownership and any irregularity in showing will be considered fraud and deception.
2. To maintain a high degree of confidence and integrity in the livestock shows, the Ozaukee County Fair Park Committee reserves the right to disqualify any animal fitted in an unethical manner and/or disqualify the exhibitor. Unethical shall include any injection of gas, solid or liquid to alter normal confirmation. In addition, it shall include any cutting or tearing of the hide, cutting or tearing underneath the hide or removal of tissue in any attempt to alter the shape or appearance. It shall also include attempts to disrupt or change normal dental development, adding artificial switches, polls, hair and heels, as well as any to change the confirmation and degree of firmness by administration of fluids internally in a liquid or solid state. The use of any medication not prescribed under a veterinarian's direction is prohibited.
3. All exhibitors, their immediate family and any other parties involved in the unethical fitting and showing of an animal will be subject to forfeiture of award(s) and premium(s), and/or dismissal from the Fair Park; and/or being barred from competition immediately in the department in which the violation has occurred and/or from all departments entered; and/or in future competition at the Ozaukee County Fair.

International Association of Fairs & Expositions (IAFE) Of Show Ethics

(Ozaukee County is member of IAFE)

Exhibitors of animals at livestock shows shall at all times deport themselves with honesty and good sportsmanship. Their conduct in this competitive environment shall always reflect the highest standards of honor and dignity to promote the advancement of agricultural education. This code applies to Junior as well as Open Class exhibitors who compete in structured classes of competition. This code applies to all livestock offered in any event at a livestock show.

Refer to "IAFE National Code of Show Ring Ethics," for more information.

In addition to the "IAFE National Code of Show Ring Ethics," fairs and livestock shows may have rules and regulations which they impose on the local, county, state, provincial and national levels.

CHECKLIST FOR ENTRIES

1. Use Premium List to determine the class entry number that fits your exhibit.
ALL 4-H Entry Class numbers begin with 4.
ALL OPEN CLASS Entry numbers begin with 3.
ALL OPEN SENIOR CLASS Entry numbers begin with 62.
2. Exhibitors are limited to one entry per class number. The category “Any Other” is only for exhibits not listed elsewhere in the Division. Other limitations are listed under respective departments. Multiple entries in the same class are **NOT** permitted.
3. Go to *Showworks* online entry system (available through [Ozaukee County Fair Website](#)) and register each participant as a “New Exhibitor.” Note: each participant gets a new account, not each family. Be sure to fill in ALL information (name, address, and CLUB name, if exhibitor is a 4-H member, on entries).
4. In *Showworks*, enter the class entry number for each exhibit that will be shown.
5. Entries in *Showworks* are **due July 1st**. Make sure that the class entry number exactly matches the description for your exhibit.
6. **No late entries accepted.**
7. No changes will be allowed after entry deadline.
8. **Print receipt** of *Showworks* class entry. Confirm exhibit is in correct class entry.
9. Deliver exhibits to the fairgrounds on the proper day. Refer to [Judging Schedule](#) located online.
10. Bring *Showworks* receipt to the County Fair to pick up your entry tags during [Entry Time](#) for your exhibit.
11. Exhibitor entry tags can be picked up in the Expo Center until noon on Wednesday of Fair week. Starting at noon on Wednesday, tags can be obtained in the Fair Office.

Note: 4-H exhibitors in non-animal departments should attach entry tags to their exhibit before entering judging area, then take a number from the appropriate department for each entry. Judging for non-animal departments is done on a first come, first serve basis. Numbers will be available 30 minutes before judging begins.

Summer yearling	Born between June 1 and August 31 of the year before exhibit year
Spring yearling	Born between March 1 and May 31 of the year before exhibit year
Winter yearling	Born between December 1 of the second year before exhibit year and February 29 of the year before exhibit year
Fall yearling	Born between September 1 and November 30 of the second year before exhibit year
Two year old	Born between September 1 of the third year before the exhibit year and August 31 of the second year before exhibit year
Three year old	Born between September 1 of the fourth year before the exhibit year and August 31 of the third year before exhibit year

ATCP 160.09 Class Definitions: Group Classes

DAIRY CATTLE TERMS

Junior get of sire	consists of 3 animals which are the offspring of the same bull. All of these animals shall be under 2 years of age, and not more than one may be a bull.
Senior get of sire	consists of 3 animals which are the offspring of one sire. All of these animals shall be 2 years of age or over. In dairy get of sire, the name of the sire shall be designated by the exhibitor. The animals need not be owned by a single exhibitor.
Produce of dam	consists of 2 animals of any age or sex which are the produce of one cow.
3 best female cattle	consists of 3 animals of any age which were bred and are owned by the exhibitor.

Open to Ozaukee County residents only

Entries must be in place after 8 p.m. Wednesday or before 5 p.m. Thursday.

1. Exhibitors of purebred cattle must submit certificate of registry, and if a purchased animal, transfer for same and the number must be on certificate of registry.
2. All animals must be good individuals, representative of the breed, and in good physical condition to merit a prize.
3. No animal may be entered in more than one class except Group classes.
4. Exhibitors must be ready to show animals when required to do so by the superintendent of the department.
5. No animal entered may be taken off the grounds before 7:00 p.m. on the last day of the fair.
6. Each exhibitor will be allowed only one entry in herds and groups.

7. To be eligible for competition, all animals must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor, except where otherwise specified, and must be owned at least 60 days by the exhibitor at the time entries close. Animals to compose competitive groups need not be named in application for entry. Sires of "get of sire" and dams of "produce of dam" to be named when making entry. Firms or partnerships must be in existence at the time of making entry.
8. All animals must be recorded or accepted for record in the recognized books of record for prospective herds.
9. In the dairy classes, heifers one year and under 2 which have calved, are to be shown in the 2 year old class. Three or more animals must be entered per class to select a champion. Both Jr. and Sr. Champions must have been selected to select a Grand Champion.
10. Only 1st prize winners in open classes may compete for championships. Champion winners only may compete for grand champions. Senior champion designates cattle 2 years old or over. Junior champions, under 2 years.
11. Where there is but a single exhibitor in the ring, one premium only may be awarded, where but two exhibitors and but two animals shown, two premiums may be awarded. However, if there be two exhibitors and three or more animals shown, three premiums may be awarded. When three or more exhibitors, all premiums may be awarded.

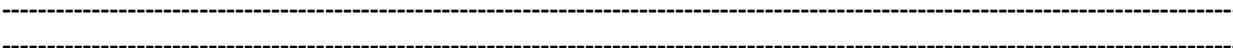
